

# Articles of Incorporation

## IMPACT 94503

### Article I

The name of this corporation is **IMPACT 94503**.

### Article II

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit **Public Benefit Corporation** and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for **public and charitable purposes**.
- B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to champion the highest professional and ethical conduct from our elected and appointed officials; to encourage voter awareness and participation in governmental affairs; to facilitate civic education for the youth of American Canyon; and to foster an environment in which public policy is openly and thoughtfully researched, debated and resolved in a positive and respectful fashion.
- C. The corporation may engage in such further and other purposes as may be permitted by law, provided however, that such purposes are authorized and approved by the Board of Directors, are in furtherance of the corporation's charitable purposes, and are of the type permitted to be performed under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3).

The Board's initial responsibility shall be to adopt a set of Bylaws which will define the duties, responsibilities and selection, of the Board and its Officers, Meetings, Membership, and how such Bylaws may be amended from time to time.

**Article IV**

- A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for **charitable** purposes within the meaning of Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3).
- B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

**Article V**

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to **charitable** purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3).
